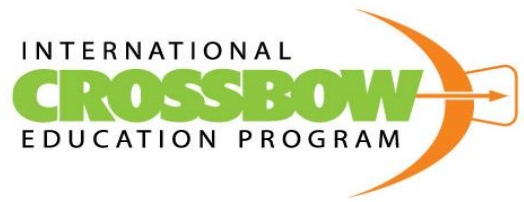


Visual Crossbow Inspection Checklist*

FOOT STIRRUP

- Bent
- Broken
- Upside-Down
- Screws/Setscrews Missing or Loose

COCKING DEVICES

- Frayed Ropes/Cords
- Cracked or Bent Pulleys and Handles

LIMBS, LIMB POCKETS, & RISER

- Splinters and/or Cracks
- Missing Bolts
- Loose, Missing, and/or Damaged Limb Tips

CAMS, WHEELS, & AXLES

- Dents and/or Bent
- Sharp Edges

STRING & CABLES

- Frayed or Broken Strands
- Separated or Damaged Servings
- Cable Saver Properly Installed
- Cable Saver not Cracked or Broken

TRIGGER BOX

- Visible Damage and/or Rust
- Safety Slide Loose and/or Moving in Barrel
- Dovetail and/or Scope Mount Loose
- Safety Knob(s) Missing

STOCK

- Cracked, Broken, and/or Missing Pieces
- Missing and/or Loose Screws

ARROW RETENTION SPRING/BRUSH

- Missing
- Bent/Broken
- Rubber Coating Torn or Missing

SAFETY ACCESSORIES

- Safety (Hand/Finger) Wings Missing
- Disabled, Damaged and/or Missing Fore-Grips

ARROWS

- Bent, Cracked and/or Damaged Shafts
- All Same Size and Material Shafts
- Appropriate Nock Size and Style on All Shafts
- Nocks are not bent, chipped, or cracked
