It is a condition of this written permission that the permission holder must, at all times while hunting or in possession of firearms and hunting equipment in a State forest pursuant to this permission, know and comply with the conditions published on the Department of Primary Industries website (dpi.nsw.gov.au/hunting/where-can-i-hunt/permission-conditions-hunting-in-nsw-state-forests). Game Hunting licence holders must also know and comply with the conditions of their Game Hunting Licence.

Other Specific Conditions

1. Mine Shaft Safety Advisory

Abandoned mines and mine shafts may occur throughout the forest and may not be shown on maps. Use caution when traversing this State forest.

STANDARD ADVISORIES

- Legislation: The Written Permission holder must at all times comply with all laws, including but not restricted to the: Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002, and Game and Feral Animal Control Regulation 2012, Forestry Act 2012 and Forestry Regulation 2012, the Crown Lands Act 1989, and the Crown Lands Regulation 2006.
- State forests and Crown Lands are public land areas and workplaces. Forestry operations and traffic may be encountered at any time.
- 3. Written Permission holders are advised to check the Rural Fire Service and Forestry Corporation of NSW websites for Hazard Reduction Burns on State Forests and Crown lands, as well as current total fire bans https://www.rfs.nsw.gov.au/fire-information/fdr-and-tobans and any other State forest closures https://www.forestrycorporation.com.au/visit/closures
- 4. Written Permission holders are encouraged to monitor UHF channel 12 when hunting on public land declared for hunting. It is recommended that UHF channel 12 be used to communicate with other Written Permission holders. Please note: this is not a requirement of this Written Permission and UHF channel 12 may not be monitored by the Department of Primary Industries, Crown Lands, Forestry Corporation of NSW or other agencies.

INDEMNITY

By acknowledging the Terms & Conditions of this Written Permission, the Written Permission holder agrees to indemnify and releases from all liability, cost, damage, or expense the NSW Department of Primary Industries being a division of the Department of Industry, Forest Corporation of NSW, Crown Lands NSW (or managing Reserve Trust) and all other servants, employees, contractors and agents resulting from damage or injury to any person or property (whether real of personal) by any act of the R-Licence holder carried out on the State forest or Crown Land area, or when entering the State forest or Crown Lands area.


